that is enough for me.



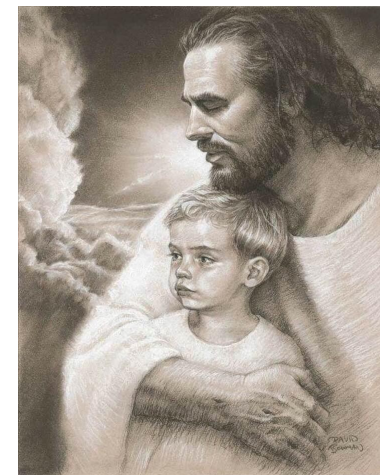
