Eucharistic Congress

The 52 Eucharistic Congress has been taking place in Budapest. This should have taken place in 2020. Eucharistic Congresses are a fundamental part of the life of the Church and have been taking place for more than 130 years. The Second Vatican Council referred to the celebration of the Eucharist as "Source and summit of our prayer life."
Pope Francis focuses on the Eucharist as very much an important part of Creation.
"The relationship between creation, renewed by the Paschal Mystery of Christ, and the Eucharist is well expressed in the fact that the first Christians gathered on the first day of the week to celebrate the Eucharist. On the first day of the week, the tomb of Christ was found empty and the Risen Lord appeared to his disciples. The Eucharist on «the Lord's day» celebrates the risen Christ. The same first day of the week, beginning with the Old Testament – recalls also the first of the seven days of Creation. This, from the beginning, Christians celebrated in the Eucharist the mystery of Christ who died and is risen, source of the new creation, while waiting for his glorious return: «Sunday is the day of the Resurrection, the "first day" of the new creation, whose first fruits are the Lord's risen humanity, the pledge of the final transfiguration of all created reality». (POPE FRANCIS, Encyclical Letter (2015) Laudato si').
For that reason, every Sunday, the Christian community celebrates the Eucharist announcing the saving death of Jesus, proclaiming his resurrection while awaiting his coming as Lord of all creation.
The Eucharist, the focus point of the praise of God on the part of all creation, nourishes our hope in the resurrection and in the transformation of the whole cosmos, and is the source of our commitment to protect creation."

Our young people in Primary 5 are preparing for their First Eucharist.

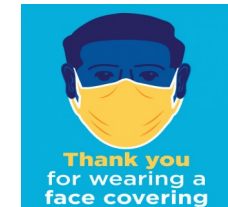
