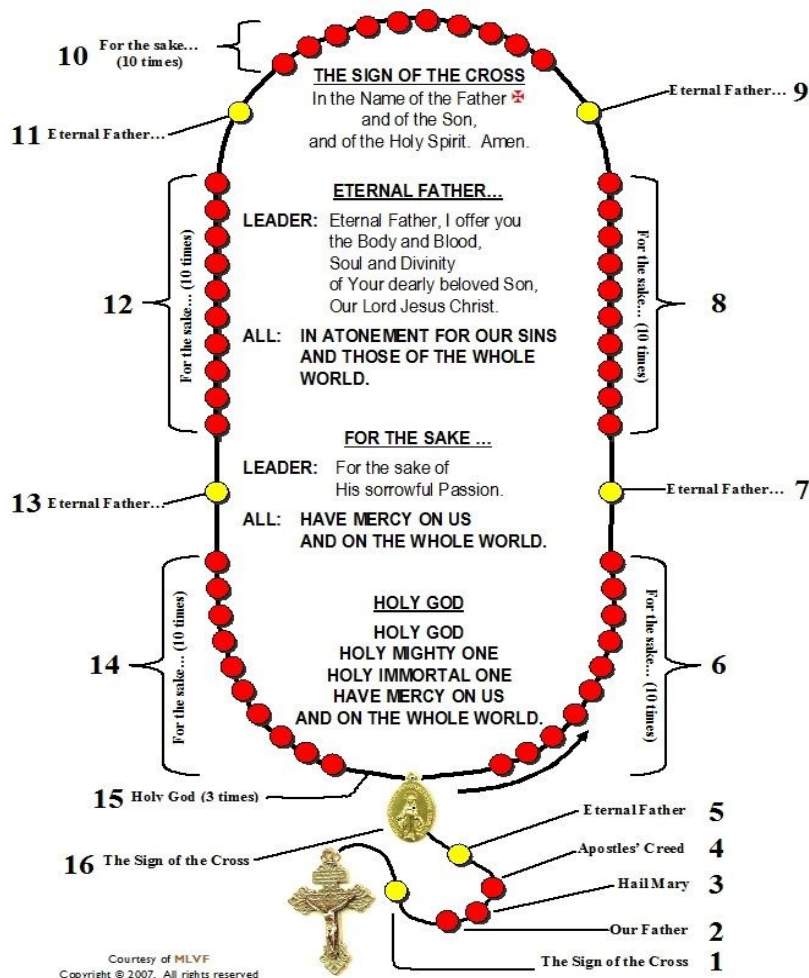


**PRAYER AT THE SENDING OUT OF THE EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS

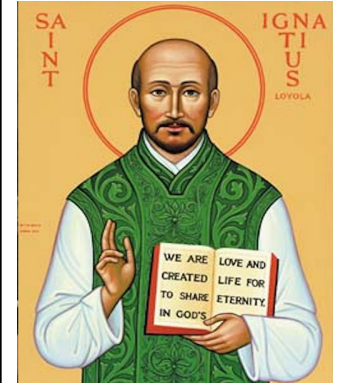
