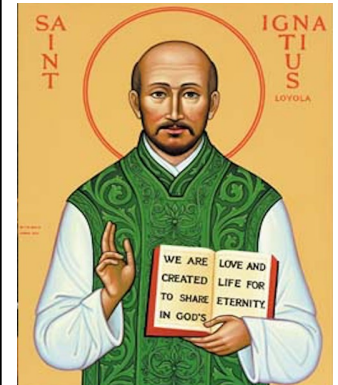
Solemnity of Corpus Christi
