a shaft that all there might have known would be an altar and a throne.**

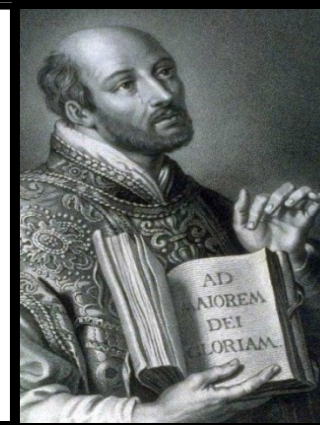
