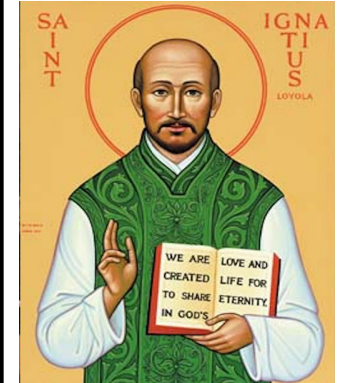
Solemnity of Pentecost
