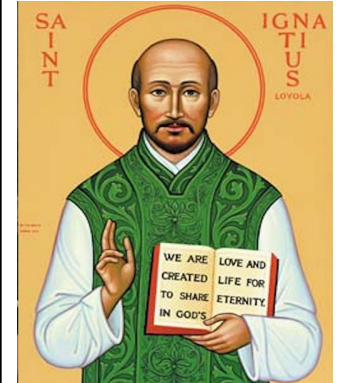
Solemnity of The Blessed Trinity

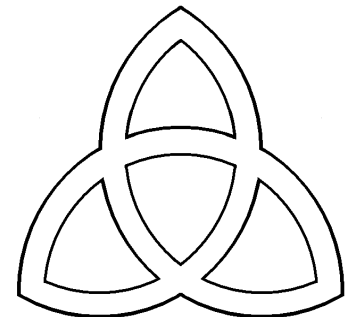
