KRAKOW 2022

It is hoped to have a parish trip to Krakow in 2022 from Monday 4th April to Friday 8th April 2022. The trip is being organised by Alba Tours in Motherwell. It is proposed that we stay in the Hotel Wyspianski in central Krakow. I've stayed in the hotel a few times and can recommend it. The Hotel lies behind the Basilica of St Mary in the main square. At the moment an overall cost can not be arranged due to flight costs which change on a regular basis. The price excluding flights, includes coach transfers to and from the airport; to and from John Paul II airport in Krakow; coach travel in Poland; the use of a guide and staying in the hotel on a halfboard basis (Bed; Breakfast and evening meal). While in Krakow, we would visit the Shrine of Divine Mercy in district of Łagiewniki; Sanctuary of St John Paul II; a visit to the Salt Mines at Wieliczka and the Jasna Gora Monastery in Czestochowa to see the Image of the Black Madonna(Our Lady of Czestochowa, Queen of Poland). The price excluding flights changes due to the number of people going. If wishing a single room a supplement of £69 is added to the person's total. 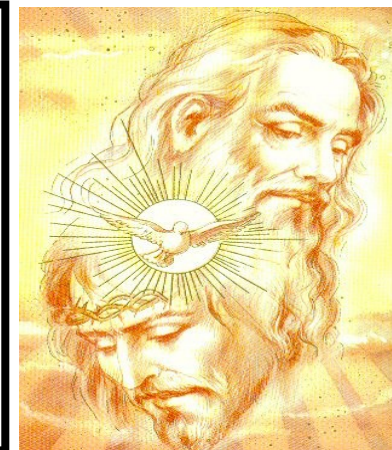
